

The Healthcare emphasis MSW Program incorporates theoretical perspectives, including a

strengths-based framework emphasizing culturally competent practice. Embracing the need to give voice to marginalized communities, The curriculum focuses on empowering diverse groups of clients to achieve their individualized goals. The Healthcare emphasis MSW Program requires the completion of 39 credits.

Program Outcomes:

- Prepare competent Advanced Generalist social workers with the knowledge, values and skills for engaging in individual, family, group, organization and community-planned change processes with diverse rural, vulnerable, disenfranchised and underserved populations locally, regionally, and globally.
- Promote identification with the profession, continued professional development and development of knowledge and skills for Advanced Generalist social work practice.
- Provide service to the community and promote human rights and social, racial, economic and environmental justice.
- Advance social work practice through the use and development of research knowledge and skills.
- Provide students with the knowledge and skills to develop and implement policy and programs and to practice from a strengths-based perspective.
- Prepare students for leadership roles in the development, implementation and evaluation of services with rural and diverse populations.
